Saskatchewan Youth Choir 2018-19



SASKATCHEWAN YOUTH CHOIR

Saskatchewan Youth Choir (SYC) is an exciting opportunity for talented youth ages 15 – 22 to perform in an SATB balanced choir with the best singers in Saskatchewan. The program develops singers ready to participate in premier vocal ensembles across Canada. Singers will be eligible to represent Saskatchewan as part of the National Youth Choir and as part of other, provincially-sponsored choral projects.

As part of their training, singers will prepare a varied program of exciting repertoire designed to enthrall audiences of all ages. The Choir will share their choral proficiency with high school and community ensembles in workshop scenarios and perform at schools, senior residences and community facilities while touring Saskatchewan.

For the 2018/19 season the SYC will be under the direction of Mrs. Marcia McLean, an accomplished choral director with a significant and varied career as a choral singer, conductor, clinician, adjudicator and private voice teacher. Marcia is currently the Artistic Director of the Swift Current Oratorio Choir and the Prairie Spirit Chamber Singers. In 2010 she retired after 18 years as Director of Choral Music at the Swift Current Comprehensive High School where she conducted an 80 voice concert choir, vocal jazz ensembles and the Comp Chamber Singers who performed across Canada at numerous festivals and won awards at Music Fest Canada and the Heritage Music Festival. Marcia was the founding director of the Swift Current Children's Choir, which she conducted for 12 years. She is a member of the Swift Current Music Festival and the Saskatchewan Choral Federation of which she was President for 4 years. On numerous occasions she was a vocal coach at the SCF choir camps and was guest conductor in 2011. In 2001, Mrs. McLean received the "Paul Harris Fellowship" from the Swift Current Rotary Club for outstanding leadership and community work with young people. In 2004, she was awarded the "Pro Musica Award" by the Saskatchewan Choral Federation for outstanding service in the choral community. Prior to teaching in Swift Current, Marcia taught music and choir at Esterhazy High School for 12 years, conducting both vocal jazz and concert choirs.

Number of Voices: 24 – 36 singers

Dates: September 2018 – February 2019

Activities:

Singers must be prepared to commit to the following dates:

1. September 21 to September 23, 2018 – Rehearsal/Regina (Friday evening to Sunday late afternoon)
2. October 26 to October 28, 2018 – Rehearsal/Regina (Friday evening to Sunday late afternoon)
3. January 4 to January 6, 2019 – Rehearsal/Regina (Friday mid-afternoon to Sunday mid-afternoon)
4. February 7 to February 10, 2019 – Rehearsal, Tour, Workshops & Concerts – locations to be confirmed (Thursday evening to Sunday late afternoon – to be confirmed)

Exact dates and times to be confirmed but will not be more than those times noted.

Cost: \$650 (maximum)

Includes choral training (sectionals, rehearsals & workshops); tour travel and accommodations and most meals at weekend rehearsals and on tour.

Travel to and from rehearsal weekends and the tour weekend will not be covered. Some meals are not included. Singers will be responsible for their own accommodations for weekend rehearsals, although some billeting will be available.

APPLICATION PROCEDURE

1. EXPRESSION OF INTEREST

Singers may be recommended by their teacher or choral director or may apply on their own. To apply for an audition, please send an email to programs@saskchoral.ca with the following information:

Expressions of interest or recommendations must be submitted by 12:00 pm (noon) Tuesday, May 22, 2018.

2. MATERIAL SUBMISSION

Singers that apply or are recommended will be sent a link to the online Chorister Questionnaire and the benchmark music piece. All audition materials must be received in the Saskatchewan Choral Federation office by midnight (11:59 pm) on Sunday, June 10, 2018. Singers must submit the following as part of their audition package:

1) Chorister Questionnaire

All prospective participants wishing to take part in the Saskatchewan Youth Choir program must complete the questionnaire. Please be as thorough as possible when answering – this information will form part of your audition package and will impact your overall audition. Specific audition requirements must be met.

2) Audition Recording

Taped video audition (YouTube, Vimeo or DVD format) including:

- Diatonic major scale (ascending and descending, non-accompanied)
- One (1) test piece provided by SCF as a benchmark
- No sight-reading component is required, but a basic level of musicianship is expected.
- Specifics will be provided upon expression of interest
- **If possible, live auditions will be arranged based on the number auditioning at any given location. You will be notified as soon as possible if that is case.**

IMPORTANT: Recording quality will affect judging – please use the best equipment possible.

3) Musical Reference

A reference letter from the student's director, voice teacher, vocal coach, or music teacher commenting on the student's:

- Work ethic
- Ability to hold a part
- Commitment
- Leadership ability
- Ability to handle SYC participation along with other commitments
